Aims/Intent

At Weston Primary & Nursery School our languages curriculum contributes to helping our children to develop as self-confident citizens, who know how to make a positive contribution as members of a global society. By developing their awareness of another culture and its language, this curriculum also aims to foster an interest more broadly in cultures and languages beyond those our children experience first-hand, as they grow up.

The Weston Curriculum for Languages aims to ensure that all pupils:

- understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources
- speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussion and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation
- can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt
- discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studied.

The language studied at Weston is French.

Curriculum Content

Pupils will be taught the following units;

Pupils in Year 3 will be taught to;

- Listen to and understand words and phrases
- Say and repeat words and short phrases
- Read words and phrases
- Write or copy words and phrases.

Pupils in Year 4 will be taught to;

- Listen to and understand words, phrases and some sentences

- Say and repeat words and short phrases and answer some short questions
- Read words and phrases and some sentences
- Write or copy words and phrases and some short sentences.

Pupils in Year 5 will be taught to;

- Listen to and understand sentences
- Answer short questions by speaking sentences
- Read sentences
- Write sentences.

Pupils in Year 6 will be taught to;

- Listen to and understand main points and some detail from spoken passages
- Take part in simple conversations and express opinions
- Read and understand main points and some detail from short paragraphs
- Write short paragraphs.

Pupils will also re-visit learning from prior year groups to reinforce connections and to help them to truly master the learning.
