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Dear Parents,

As you know, we have had to close the 'bubble' for critical workers'/vulnerable children in Years 4, 5 and 6 after a member of staff in that 'bubble' tested positive for Covid-19. As a result, all of these children are now required to self-isolate and complete the home learning. In addition to the staff member who tested positive, we have now been informed of 2 pupils from the same group who have also tested positive. This should reinforce to all of us the importance of following the lockdown rules, to reduce the risk to everyone else in the community.

The home learning packs and exercise books will be available again from Friday at 5pm until Sunday evening and this will continue throughout the course of this lockdown. I would suggest that all parents collect a maths/writing/spare exercise book in case of future bubble closures. I will ensure we have plenty of spares available. Unfortunately, because of safety, we cannot allow collection of these at any other time as stated in the previous letter.

Thank you for all the positive feedback about the Google Classroom learning and we have made a few adjustments as a result of requests. All the week's tasks will be visible from Friday evening so you can map out your week. We are still trying hard to get Hardy class up and running again, possibly recreating a new classroom if this is quicker than waiting for the engineers to fix it. We are currently in a long queue! We will send out new passwords and
