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Dear Parents,

I am overwhelmed and very impressed with the responses to the home learning on the Google Classroom and we are marking all the learning as quickly as we can. Thank you for bearing with us whilst we are uploading the daily learning activities and videos. We are trying very hard to learn all the functionality of Google Classroom as a learning platform and hopefully this will provide a better home learning experience.

Yesterday, I found out that Google classroom can be accessed via an Xbox or PlayStation and I got my son to test this on his PlayStation 4 and it worked! This may improve your access at home if you have one of these devices.

For years 1-6, the **compulsory** 'core learning' will consist of a daily English lesson, a daily Maths lesson and one other subject. In addition, there will be further ad hoc optional lessons and activities. Home learning is now not optional; all children not attending school are expected to complete the compulsory learning!

For Reception and Nursery, the **compulsory** 'core learning' will consist of a daily phonics/Literacy lesson, a daily Maths lesson and a daily reading activity. In addition there will be an optional 4th activity.

On Friday at 5pm until Sunday evening, we will recommence the learning pack/book collections. This will allow no crossover of parents of pupils in school with 'at home' parents to improve safety. Please do not arrive at any other time or ask another school parent to collect as these books/packs will not be available at other times! These will be placed outside under the Robinson class canopy in labelled boxes just like last time!

Please take one Maths (squared), English (blue) and spare (green) exercise book from the class boxes and one pencil, one ruler and one handwriting pen. Please do not take anymore than one of each otherwise they will run out and some children won't get them.
